# Repurpose

---

## SPRAY TOPS

Spray tops are an ideal solution for reusing your empty oil bottles. Make a throat spray, a kitchen cleaner or a facial mist by placing a spray top onto your old essential oil bottle. See recipes from next page.

## EMPTY BOTTLES

Empty essential oil bottles or even roller bottles are great when you need to take just a few softgels with you. Ideal when you travel light.

## ROLLER TOPS

Roller top is great for oils and oil blends you use often topically (e.g face serum, signature scent). Roller top turns a regular essential oil bottle into a roller bottle.

## DROPPER

Remove the reducer and lid from standard bottles and replace them with a dropper for easy use. Perfect for thicker essential oils but great for face serums too. See recipe from next page.

## HAND SANITIZER

- 10 drops OnGuard®
- 10 drops Wild Orange

Fill with water

## SORE THROAT

- 10 drops OnGuard®
- 10 drops Lemon

Fill with water

## AIR FRESHENER

- 15 drops Purify

Fill with water

## FACIAL MIST

- 10 drops Lavender
- 10 drops Frankincense

Fill with Witch Hazel or Rose Water

## HAIR SPRAY

- 5 drops Lavender
- 5 drops Rosemary

Add 1 teaspoon sugar and fill with water

## AFTER SUN

- 10 drops Lavender
- 10 drops Peppermint

Fill with water

## KITCHEN CLEANER

- 20 drops Wild Orange or Lemon

Fill with water

## PILLOW SPRAY

- 20 drops Lavender or Serenity®

Fill with water

## HAIR SCENT

- 10 drops Ylang Ylang
- 10 Lavender

Fill with water

## HOLIDAY ROOM SPRAY

- 5 drops Douglas Fir
- 5 drops Frankincense
- 5 drops Grapefruit

Fill with water

## FIRST AID

- 10 drops Melaleuca
- 10 drops Lavender

Fill with water or FCO

## FACE SERUM

- 20 drops Copaiba

Fill with Jojoba or Argan oil

## AFTER SHAVE SPRAY

- 10 drops Lavender
- 5 drops Frankincense
- 5 drops Helichrysum

Fill with FCO
